

5. What if my child wishes to return after a break?

If your child has a break from coaching for a duration of one coaching course, you may book your child back in the same age group / level. However you will not have priority and will only be considered for a place at the same time as the reserves.

If your child has missed more than one coaching term then they will need an assessment to agree the appropriate level and course and then go on the reserve list.

Please note:

When reserve places have been offered, no place will be guaranteed until payment is received.

West Bridgford Tennis Club Junior Coaching Programme

1. What is the junior tennis programme?

The junior coaching programme enables children from the age of 3 to 18 years to take up tennis and develop at their own ability within their age groups.

In each class, children will develop the technical, tactical, physical and mental skills appropriate to their age and ability.

In line with the LTA mini tennis initiative, children will play on court sizes and with the type of ball appropriate for their level of skill.

2. How can my child join the coaching programme?

All new applicants can join the reserve list at reception.

Following the re-booking and transfer period for players currently on our programme, (see point 3) we will contact you to offer any courses that are available.

If a new applicant applies to join during a course, then a place may be given if an appropriate course has a place available, otherwise you can join the reserve list for the following term.

3. How will my child move up a level?

The following grid demonstrates how children will progress through the programme.

Club Courses
Mini Tennis Blue—3 to 4 years
Mini Tennis Red—Levels 3, 2, 1
Mini Tennis Orange—Levels 3, 2, 1
Mini Tennis Green/Beginner Tennis—Levels 3, 2, 1
Beginner/Improver 13+
Improver—11 to 13 years
Advanced Improver—11 to 13 years
Match Teenage Squad

Players who show particular potential can be invited to attend squads that will be more appropriate to their ability. The grid below demonstrates the progression through this pathway.

Development	Performance
Teenage	Performance Mini Red
Team Performance 3	Performance Mini Orange
Team Performance 2	Performance Mini Green
Team Performance 1	12 & under Performance

Towards the end of each coaching course your child's coach will recommend whether your child should remain at their current level or move up to the next level in their termly report.

If your child is already in the coaching programme you will have priority to rebook before we offer places to reserves.

During the priority rebooking period you can either book your child back into the class they are currently in or you can apply for them to transfer into a new class level / day / time. The transfer applications will be processed collectively at the end of the priority booking period.

If you are applying for re-booking or transfer, payment needs to be made with the application form. **No applications will be considered without payment.**

Please refer to the coaching programme leaflet for details and dates on the rebooking procedure.

4. What will happen if I forget to rebook?

If you forget to rebook within the priority time, please contact the tennis club as soon as possible to see when you can rebook your child. Please note however we may not be able to advise you until all the transfers have been completed.

If there are no appropriate spaces at your child's age / level, please ask at reception to discuss possible alternatives.
